STEP BY STEP

Whether it's the end of term, the end of the year or your exams, you're achievements should be celebrated! You and your classmates have been through so much together. You've shared the good times as well as the bad times. This could be your last chance to party together before you go your separate ways - onto college or university perhaps, maybe you're off travelling or heading out into the big wide world in search of your first real job!

Wherever you're heading next, you'll always be friends. And you'll always have this moment to look back on, so make sure it's an event to remember!

STEP 2

ESTIMATE YOUR GUEST LIST

You should have a rough idea of your maximum and likely guest numbers to ensure your venue is suitable. We will also agree to a minimum contracted amount of people attending the event.

Start with the number of students in your year group. You should expect 80-90% of this number to attend an end of year prom but this may be slightly less for Christmas Events.

Next decide whether guests will be allowed to bring a partner or friend. If so, expect around 75% of guests to do so.

STEP 1

CHOOSE YOUR DATE

The date you choose is very important. Ideally you want everyone to be able to attend your event.

For end of year events try to pick a date within the first few weeks after exams finish. For Christmas events aim for a date the week before term ends. This way you'll catch most of your class before the school holidays.

Try to avoid Friday and Saturday nights as family commitments can often reduce the number of guests who are free. There may also be more limited availability at the venue at the weekend.
